FOUR MORE NEON 200X PLAYERS NAB TOP PRIZES SIXTY-SIX \$50,000 PRIZES REMAIN

LITTLE ROCK— The twelfth, thirteenth, fourteenth, and fifteenth Neon 200X top prize winners have claimed their \$50,000 prizes! The latest Neon 200X top prize winners are Harold Reed of Paragould, Jeffrey Miles of Marmaduke, Joseph Dale of Russellville and Stacy Schmoll of Hattieville. Neon 200X is a \$20 instant game from the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery that launched August 30 loaded with more than eighty \$50,000 top prizes. Sixty-six \$50,000 top prizes remain to be claimed in this game.

In their winners' statements, Mr. Reed said he's a frequent lottery player, and the first person he told about the win was his wife; he plans to use the prize for a down payment on a house. Mr. Miles first told his brother, and is going to buy a car with his prize and give some of the winnings to his church. Mr. Dale first told his dad – and said he plans to pay back the "people who have helped him along the way." Ms. Schmoll first told her husband and plans to pay off her mortgage. The respective winning tickets were sold at Divine Gas, 500 Highway 49 North, in Paragould; at Quick Stop, 11402 Highway 49 North, in Marmaduke; Dardanelle Food and Gas, 115 Union St., in Dardanelle; and at LBJ, 2087 Highway 95, in Hattieville; the retailers will receive a 1% commission on the sale.

About \$20 Neon 200X

Neon 200X has more than \$20 million in cash prizes – including \$3.3 million remaining in \$50,000 top prizes. Top prize odds for Neon 200X are 1 in 19,259; overall odds are 1 in 3.13. (The Arkansas Scholarship Lottery is unable to determine how many winning tickets are lost or purchased but still remain unclaimed. Prizes remaining are updated daily.)
