

## \$160,000 Arkansas Natural State Jackpot Winner

Press Release From the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery Little Rock, Arkansas Wednesday, May 14, 2014

Tuesday's Jackpot of \$160,000, has a winner! This amount marked as one of largest Natural State Jackpot's won in the game! The games popularity and this Jackpot amount is a direct result of Arkansas player interest and excitement in the game. The game had not reached this level of play, number of consecutive draws without a top prize winner (27 draws) or Jackpot range since the record breaking \$410,000 Jackpot Run, won on April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2014. There has been 536 drawings since the game's first on August 27<sup>th</sup>, 2012. The Natural State Jackpot celebrates the newest Jackpot Winner in the game! The success of the game captured the imagination and anticipation of its players, the Natural State Jackpot was won by a player who correctly match the five NSJ numbers drawn last night. In last night's NSJ drawing there were 6 players who match four of the five numbers drawn, each of those players were just one away from winning the Jackpot amount. The odds of matching four of the five numbers drawn are just 1 in 3,387.

With over 28,000 tickets sold yesterday and the over 575,000 possible NSJ number combinations that could be drawn, one player correctly choose and correctly matched the five unique numbers drawn in the May 13<sup>th</sup> Natural State Jackpot drawing. *The winner of the latest Natural State Jackpot is Herschel Caples*. Herschel and his wife live in the town of Jonesboro. Herschel hasn't told anyone yet he's won and plans to surprise his wife with news tonight, no plans yet for his prize of \$160,000. We are thrilled for them and all the Arkansas players who made this NSJ run exciting! [Herschel is pictured in the attached photo].

The winning Natural State Jackpot ticket was purchased at the Tobacco Superstore location on Johnson Avenue in the city of Jonesboro, Arkansas. We would like to *Congratulate The Winner* and all the Arkansan's who participated, had fun and have made this Natural State Jackpot Run so exciting.

A portion of *all game sales* contribute directly to Arkansas education, approximately 50% of the NSJ game sales can be counted as return for the lottery to support scholarships in the state, for current and graduating high school seniors. The **Natural State Jackpot** begins the *next Jackpot Run* tonight, with the starting amount of \$25,000.

The Natural State Jackpot is a Five Number Game (5 of 39), one of the most popular games offered by lotteries, they are considered quite winnable by players. They offer growing Jackpot amounts with some

of the lowest overall odds of any Jackpot game offered. NSJ has had 20 top prize winners in the last 505 drawings, that averages out to one in twenty-five drawings held. Winning any Jackpot drawing depends on having a ticket for the drawing that matches all the numbers drawn. The odds of winning the NSJ are 1 in 575,757, the overall odds of winning a prize in the game 1 in 9.

NSJ players choose just 5 numbers between 1 and 39 in this game and player's can choose to play up to 20 consecutive draws in NSJ. Each play costs \$1. The game is drawn six nights a week (Monday through Saturday), at 8:00 P.M. (CST)

Players matching two numbers will win \$1; three numbers win \$7; four matching numbers win \$300, and all five numbers will win the jackpot, guaranteed to be worth at least \$25,000. Each night in which there is no big winner, an additional \$5,000 is added to the jackpot. If there is more than one jackpot winner, the prize will be equally divided among all the jackpot prize winners. The overall odds of winning are one in nine. \*The Natural State Jackpot prize amount is pre-tax. Tickets sold based on sales data.
