ARKANSAS SCHOLARSHIP LOTTERY ANNOUNCES 50th MILLIONAIRE

APRIL 5, 2016

LITTLE ROCK— The Arkansas Scholarship Lottery (ASL) has reached a milestone in a club most everyone wants to join – the ranks of millionaires. Last week, Jeff Hornback of Jonesboro became **the 50th million-dollar prize winner** since the Lottery began seven years ago.

Hornback actually purchased a non-winning instant game ticket at the Parker BP convenience store on West Parker Drive in Jonesboro, but then he entered the ticket number into his free ASL *Play it Again* Rewards Club account which gives players a second chance to win with losing tickets. On March 28, his ticket was drawn to win the \$1,000,000 prize in the Platinum Payout *Play it Again* Drawing Number 49. Still overwhelmed when he claimed his prize March 30, Hornback said he plans to invest some of his prize money, spend some on his grandchildren and help others with the rest.

Randall Irvin of Uniontown was the first million-dollar ASL winner, with his Jan. 22, 2010 win, just months after the Lottery's 2009 launch. In between, the Lottery has made millionaires all over the state – in Atkins, Pearcy, Bono, Sulphur Rock, Grubbs, Diaz, Hamburg, Lepanto, Marmaduke, McRae and beyond. Below is a complete list of winners and their hometowns.

ASL Director Bishop Woosley said this is just "the first" 50 ASL millionaires – noting that nearly \$2 billion overall has been awarded to Lottery players.

"The state of Arkansas has 50 more millionaires now than before the Lottery's launch," Woosley said. "Their lives have changed forever, and hopefully our winners will always have financial security. We're proud of them. We're also proud of the scholarships our players and retailers provide to college students in the state, since obtaining a college degree is the surest way to financial security."

About Scholarships

The Arkansas Scholarship Lottery Act of 2009 provided for revenue raised by a state lottery to provide for college scholarships, to be administered by the Arkansas Department of Higher Education (ADHE). As a result, tens of thousands of Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarships are awarded to Arkansas residents for in-state colleges and universities across the state annually.

Since Lottery sales started in Arkansas in 2009, the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery has accumulated more than \$573 million in net proceeds for scholarships, Lottery players have won nearly \$2 billion in prizes, and Lottery retailers have earned more than \$162 million in commissions. More than 92 cents of every dollar of Lottery revenue goes to prizes, scholarships and retailer commissions in the state.
