

The \$1 Million Arkansas Powerball® Winner is:

Nancy Silvers of Berryville, Arkansas

Press Release From the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery Little Rock, Arkansas Monday, April 7, 2014

The Saturday's \$70 Million Powerball® Jackpot had no top prize winner. The drawing held at 9:59 P.M. (CT), however did have BIG results for two lucky players in Arkansas. The ticket purchased in Eureka Springs, at the Rapid Roberts location on E. Van Buren matched the first five numbers drawn, winning that player a cool million dollars (\$1,000,000), the lucky player asked for a Quick Pick (QP) ticket for the Saturday draw and that player is: Nancy Silvers.

Nancy and her husband William came into the Arkansas Lottery Claims Center in Little Rock, this afternoon to claim the \$1 Million Powerball® prize she won in the Saturday night Powerball® drawing. Nancy shared the winning information first with her husband and her mother, prior to claiming the prize. Nancy intends to start enjoying her Powerball® prize by paying off some of her debts, while she makes additional plans for the prize. (Nancy is pictured with her husband William).

The second lucky ticket sold in Arkansas, in the Saturday night drawing was in Springdale, at the Kum & Go on Old Missouri. That lucky ticket sold at that lottery retail location correctly matched four of the first five numbers drawn plus the Powerball for a **\$10,000** prize, and that lucky player has yet to claim their prize.

Even without a top prize jackpot winner in the Saturday Powerball® drawing, **1,770 Arkansas players** in the game won prizes ranging from \$4 to \$500. Overall odds of winning a prize 1 in 31.8

Powerball® has risen to \$80 Million, for the Wednesday April 9th drawing.

Powerball® is a multi-state jackpot game. Drawings are held at 9:59 p.m. CST every Wednesday and Saturday. Five numbered balls are drawn from 1 to 59 and one numbered ball is drawn from 1 to 35. If all your numbers match those that are chosen, you win the jackpot, which starts at \$40 million and grows until someone wins. If other players also match all six numbers, the prize will be shared in equal

amounts. Each Powerball® play is \$2. For an additional dollar, you can add the PowerPlay® option to increase non-jackpot winnings by as much as a million dollars.

There were three addition winners in the game who won \$1 Million each in New Mexico, Oregon, and Texas and one additional player in New York who purchased the PowerPlay® option and won a Match 5 prize worth \$2 Million, in the Saturday April 5th Powerball® drawing. The odds of winning a million dollar prize in the game are 1 in 5,153,633.

There was *no top prize winner* in the **Natural State Jackpot** Saturday night, Monday's Jackpot is **now \$375,000** and if NSJ rolls tonight the Jackpot will be **\$400,000** Tuesday night. The Tuesday night **Mega Millions**® Jackpot is estimated to be **\$15 Million**.
