CAMDEN LOTTERY CLAIMS CENTER OPENS TUESDAY JAN. 5; MILEAGE NO LONGER OFFERED TO PRIZE WINNERS

Little Rock (for immediate release) -- Arkansas Scholarship Lottery players with winning tickets can take them to the ASL Claim Center in the Garden Oaks Center off Cash Road in Camden, which opens its doors on Tuesday, January 5. The location is about two-thirds of a mile north of Highway 278 near the intersection of Cash Road and Highway 4/Washington Street.

Lottery Claim Centers have no cash on hand and pay all claims by check, and they do not sell lottery tickets.

A Grand Opening Event for the Camden Center will be announced in a few weeks, with the public invited to attend for the ribbon cutting, refreshments, appearances by local and area officials, and nonstop spinning of the big wheel with a prize for every spin. The Grand Opening date and time will be announced soon.

With the opening of the Camden Claim Center, prize claimants are no longer eligible to receive mileage reimbursement if they cash a prize at the Little Rock Claim Center at 124 West Capitol in the Union Plaza Building.

The Camden Center specifically serves counties across south Arkansas. All Lottery retailers cash prizes of \$500 or less. Prizes of any denomination less than \$1,000,000.00 may be claimed at any of the four centers currently open in Little Rock, Springdale, Jonesboro and Camden. Prizes of \$1,000,000 or more must be claimed in Little Rock.
