18 Arkansas Powerball Players Win on Saturday Night

LITTLE ROCK, June 13, 2010 -- Saturday night, June 12, saw an unusual number of big wins in Arkansas. No Powerball player matched the winning jackpot numbers. The Powerball Jackpot for June 16 will roll upward to \$60,000. Arkansas had 18 big winners at \$10,000 and \$100 and all of those spent the extra \$1 on PowerPlay and increased their wins to \$100,000 and \$1,000 respectively. The PowerPlay multiplier Saturday night was 10X. The two Arkansas Powerball \$100,000 tickets were sold at Pic N Tote 5 in Fort Smith and Satterfield 4 in Conway. The 16 \$1000 winners bought their tickets at these locations: Darrell's Hillside in Russellville, Clark's Food Mart in Star City, Crackerbox 37 in Little Rock, Extra Stop # 6 in Bryant, EZ Mart in Glenwood, Frederick's One Stop in Prairie Grove, Jet Away in Fort Smith, Jacks in Fairfield Bay, Speedway 102 in Pine Bluff, Oak Street Shell in Conway, Flash Market #21 in Sherwood, Doug Eastside Convenience Corner in Fort Smith, C&J Quick Stop in Van Buren, Alford Tobacco 2 in Cabot, Tobacco Super Store in Pine Bluff and C&H Grocery in Royal.

The two \$100,000 winners matched four of the five white balls, plus the Powerball numbers, and added PowerPlay. The sixteen \$1000 winners matched four numbers—either four of the five white ball numbers or three of the five white ball numbers plus the Powerball number.

Winners will be able to claim their prizes at the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery Claim Centers in Little Rock, Camden, Springdale, or Jonesboro. Winners' identities will not be known until the prizes are claimed.
