## **LOTTO Jackpot Skyrockets to \$4.929 Million**

LITTLE ROCK, Ark. — The LOTTO jackpot rises to \$4.929 million for tomorrow night's drawing.

Played and won exclusively in Arkansas, LOTTO is designed to offer in-state players more chances to win bigger prizes. Previous jackpot winners include residents from Sebastian County and Pulaski County.

Drawings are held every Wednesday and Saturday at 9 p.m. Tickets cost \$2 per play, and sales cut off at 8:59 p.m.

Six numbers between 1 and 40 are drawn, plus a Bonus Number. To win the jackpot, a LOTTO player must match the first six numbers drawn in any combination. Alternate prizes up to \$25,000 are available for players who match three or more winning numbers, with or without the Bonus Number.
